SHOW CAUSE before this court in its courtroom at 300 South Spring Street, Los Angeles, California, on November 10, 2021, at 9:00 a.m., why a peremptory writ of mandate should not issue on the ground that petitioners have demonstrated that they are entitled to have their fourth set of requests for admissions deemed admitted because, before the hearing on the motion, real party in interest did not file a proposed response to the requests for admission in substantial compliance with Code of Civil Procedure section 2033.220, as established by section 2033.280, subdivision (c). (See *St. Mary v. Superior Court* (2014) 223 Cal.App.4th 762, 774-778, 783-784.)

Any written return shall be served and filed on or before September 15, 2021.

Petitioners may file a reply on or before September 29, 2021.

In the event that respondent court complies with alternative (a) of this writ at any time prior to November 10, 2021, petitioners shall immediately so advise this court by letter and file a certified copy of the order constituting such compliance.
